

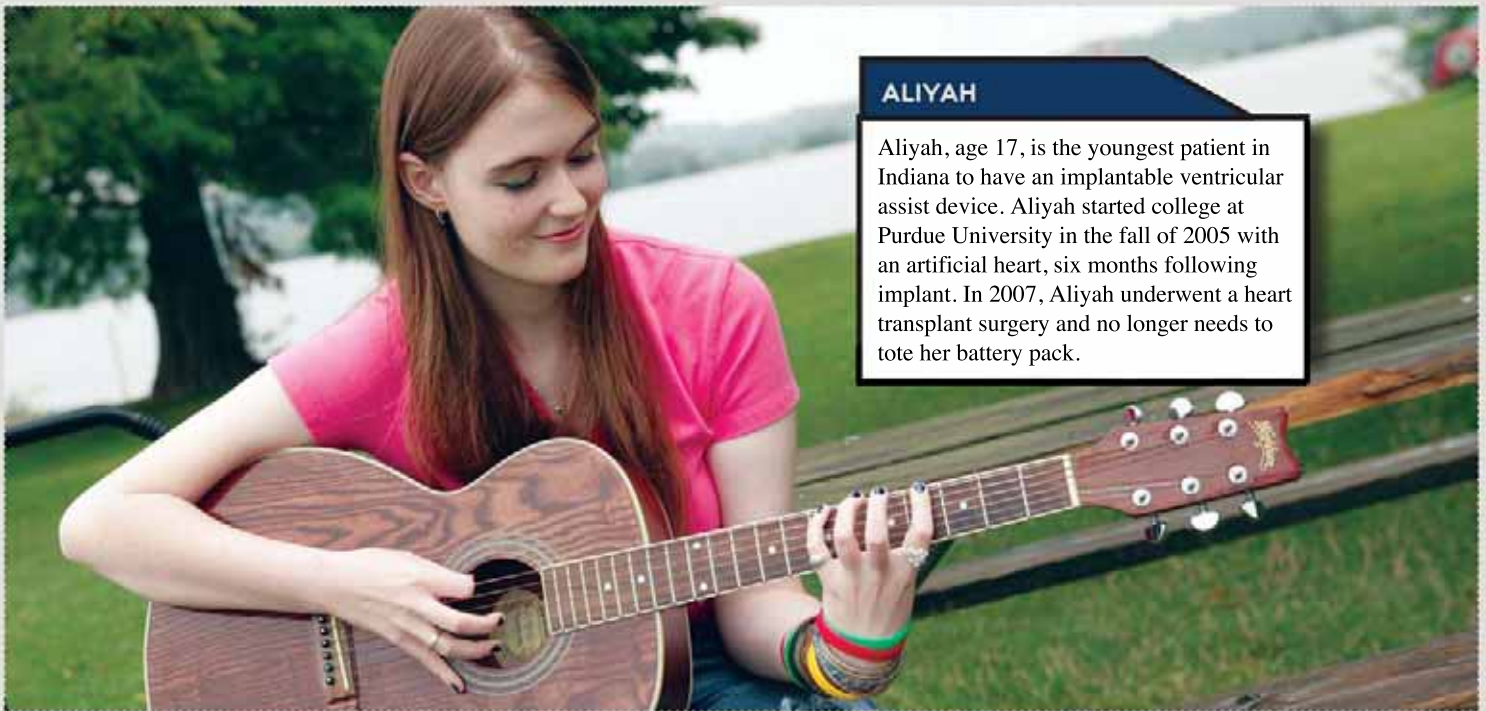
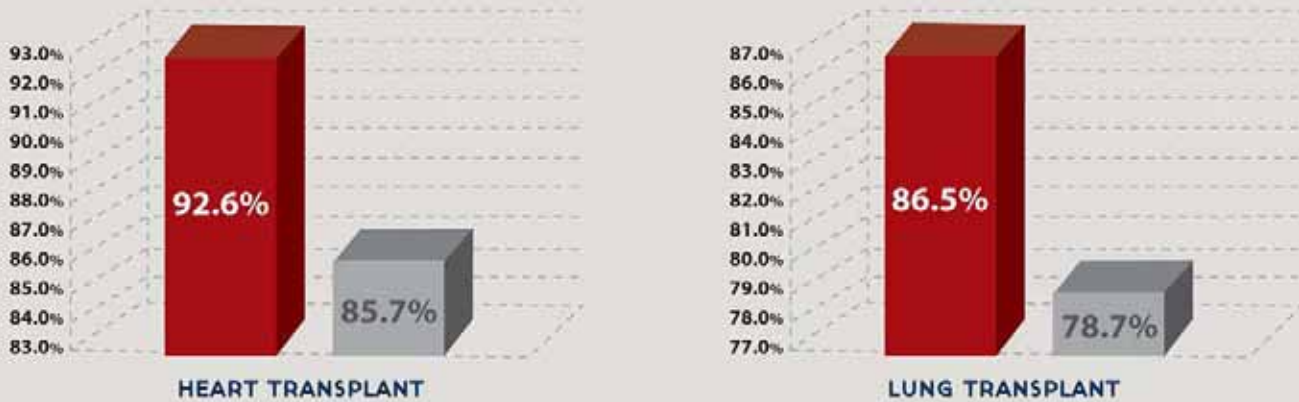

Aliyah started college at Purdue University in the fall of 2005 with an artificial heart, six months following implant. In 2007, Aliyah underwent a heart transplant surgery and no longer needs to tote her battery pack.
